## INDIAN PRIME MINISTER NARENDRA MODI MEETS FRANCOIS HOLLANDE AND SIGNS CONTRACTS

### AND AGREEMENTS WITH FRANCE

**USPA NEWS** - At the invitation of the French President, Francois Hollande, Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi paid an official visit to France on 10-11 April 2015. France and India signed 17 agreements including security, climate change, defense, and nuclear energy. A constructive marathon in two days.

A CONSTRUCTIVE MARATHON IN TWO DAYS TO STRENGTHEN COOPERATION BETWEEN FRANCE AND INDIA-----The Indian Prime Minister, Mr Narendra Modi has made a constructive marathon in 2 days, during his visit to France (From 10 to 11 April 2015). A short tour that has allowed Narendra Modi to sign several commercial agreements and cooperation between France and India, while visiting the headquarters of some key French companies, UNESCO and afford a ride "Bateaux Parisiens" crossing the Seine. This demand for getaway "tourist" unpublished, on a barge, came from the Indian Prime Minister, that he made (just before the signing of contracts for the purchase of "Rafales" Jets alongside François Hollande, President, Laurent Fabius, Minister Foreign Affairs and Anne Hidalgo Mayor of Paris. A moment of pleasure and cultural relaxation across the Seine to better admire Paris to enjoy the taste of Indian Prime Minister.-----

After lengthy discussions, debates and other exchanges, followed by small boat ride, signatures were held in the wake at the Elysee Palace, followed by a press briefing before international journalists. President François Hollande spoke in French, while the Prime Minister Modi spoke in Hindi. Translations were available for the hearing.-----

By leaving France, Indian Prime Minister, went to Germany and Canada for two successive official visits since taking office in May 2014. At the meeting in "the Elysee Palace" that followed the signing of contracts and agreements between the two countries, the President of the Republic addressed M Modi, Prime Minister India, "I am very sensitive your willingness to buy 36 "Rafales" in the best details and sign contracts". The head of French state, Francois Hollande called on similar historical past from one side, France has marked the history with the Revolution of 1789, and the other side, India has accessed to the independence in 1947. A historical past is also marked by partnerships registered in strategic continuity and bringing the two countries in the future. President Francois Hollande said that France and India have respectively been affected by terrorism and that "Whenever India is attacked it is the same for France and vice versa".

### A SIMILAR PAST LIKE EACH ONE ANOTHER HAD MAKE A REVOLUTION /OR ACCESS TO ITS INDEPENDENCE

The French President François Hollande recalls, "Access to Independence" of India, that was won on August 15, 1947, following the peaceful and non violent, revolution of Mahatma Gandhi and through the victory over the British colonization. India controlled by the British Empire since the 17th century, lead to the Independence of India, by the Movement for Independence.

The French president Hollande, recalls the recent terrorist attacks to France in January 2015 and the souvenir of Mumbai Terrorist attacks in 2008.

The attacks of Mumbai in 2008 has made the November 2008 attacks in Mumbai are a series of ten coordinated attacks Islamist terrorists that took place from 26 to 29 November 2008 through Mumbai, the financial capital and largest city of India. 173 people, including at least 26 foreign nationals were killed and 312 injured.-----

In France, which was attacked by terrorists who killed 17 people 7 January 2015 have resulted in a silent march to 2 million people in Paris, now called "The March of 11 January."
